1. Go to http://www.EuchrePad.com to generate Euchre Score Cards.



2. Click the image to start the score card wizard.


3. Select a format: Personalized, Personal Lite, Tally or Vegas

- 6. Press, Continue, then download the scorecards, datafile and Leaderboard software.
 - a. Press the 'Download Score Sheets' button



After you download leaderboard.zip, you need to do several steps before you can run Leaderboard.

- 1. Navigate to the directory where you downloaded the zip file.
- 2. Unzip the download, using Winzip or an equivalent program
- 3. Double-click on Setup to install Leaderboard

Then click on the Windows Start button



1. Load Data File



The first thing that you will want to do is to import your datafile into Leaderboard. You do this by pressing the "Load" tab, then pressing the Load button.




2. Collect Entry Fee



After the file is loaded, you can collect your entry fees. If everyone has paid, then you can reflect this by pressing the 'Set All' button. Otherwise, as people pay you, you can simply check on the checkbox preceding the player's name.

3. Fees / Payout

Now you can setup your fees and payouts.




If you want to change the default percentage payouts, then press the Setup % button in the center of the Payout Tab. You will see the following screen where you can modify the payouts.



Timer Tab

The Timer is helpful, it tells you the average game time and the estimated finish time. It even has a progress bar to let you know how close you are to finishing an "average" round. If you want to use the timer, just press the Start button right before you begin playing.



Roster Tab



This screen will show all of the players and player data in the tournament. Any row that has dashes, indicates that they are 'sitting out' for that game. This only occurs when you have 'extra' players.

Leaders Tab

The Leaders grid is the main tab while you are playing. It shows all of the important data.

The Leaders grid contains the current rank and who is in the money. There is also data on who owes bump money.

If you are playing with 'extra' players, then the players sitting out for the current round will be listed at the bottom of the screen.



Scores Tab



When you click on the 'Scores' tab, you will first be prompted if you want to start the Tournament Timer.



All players that need a score for a round have an asterisk preceding their name. As you enter player scores, the player name is removed from the drop-list. This is to speed up the data entry process. If you want to see all of the players, just check the "Show All" checkbox.

TIP: Enter the bumps, woodpeckers and Lone data before you enter the score data. As soon as the score is entered, the player name drops off the player list, if the "Show All" checkbox is not checked.

Scores: When you enter the score for a player, his/her partner will receive the same score. This is also a time saver.

Bumps and Woodpeckers Lones: These are cumulative, they do not need to be entered after each game. You should, however enter the values every 5 or more games. When you desire to enter these values, be sure to enter them BEFORE you enter the score, because as soon as you enter the score, the Player combo advances to the next player.

If you want to see a players partner, just click the "Show Partner" button. Notice that the text on the button changes to "Show Opponents". Click the button again and you will see the opponents of the currently selected player.

Select Round: This allows you to go any previous round to check/change scores.

Show/Hide Partner: This will allow you to see More/Less player data

Show/Hide Opponent: This will allow you to see More/Less player data

Scores Needed: This indicates how many players on the current round that needs their scores entered.

Show All: This will show all players for the round, both those that need their score entered and those who have entered their score entered.

Auto-Add Partner Score: When checked, this will save you time. As you enter a players score, that score is 'auto' added to the partner.

Paid: At the end of the tournament, if you want to indicate who have 'paid' for their bumps and woodys.

Bumps/Woodpeckers/Lones


Bumps/Woodpeckers/Lones are cumulative. They don't need to be entered after each game, but should be entered before the end of the tournament.

Once all of the scores have been entered for a round, you will be prompted. Press OK and it will automatically advance to the next round.



End of Tournament

After you enter the last scores for the last round, you will be prompted that the tournament is over and to click on the Results. Tab.



Results Tab

The Results Tab has three sub-tabs: Winners, Bumps and Lotto. To make payouts even easier, you can check the 'Drop Cents' checkbox and it will drop the cents on the payouts.




Bumps Sub-Tab

TIP: When collecting bump money, you can easily keep track of who paid by checking the checkbox for each player.



Lotto Sub-Tab

If you are using the Lotto feature, then on the Lotto sub-tab you will see the ranking of the players poker hand. Cards are 'drawn' on the Top-Level Lotto Tab.




Details Tab

If you want to look at individual game scores for each player, then click on the Details Tab



When you double-click on a row, you will see even more details that resemble the Personalized Score Card. This makes resolving discrepancies even easier. If you are playing with 'extra' players, then any line that has dashes '—', indicates that the player sat out that game. You will notice that they receive 'Bye' points for the game. The 'Bye' points are set-up in Setting.




Alias Tab

If you are using a Theme on your scorecard, you may want to create an alias for your players



Lotto

On this tab you 'draw' cards. Players can see these cards at the bottom of the Dual Monitor. On the Results Tab, there is a Lotto Sub-Tab. You can see how all of the Players Rank. The person with the highest hand gets a prize. We usually take \$5.00 or \$10.00 out of the bump money.



Dual Monitor


If you want to use a second monitor, then you will be able to display important leader details. This works best if Leaderboard is running on a Laptop and you connect a second monitor into the monitor port on the Laptop. Then you need to extend your monitor to the second monitor. Activate the second monitor by pressing the "Dual Monitor" button at the bottom-right of Leaderboard. The Dual monitor is only updated when a round is completed and all of the scores for the round have been entered. You can force a refresh by simply pressing the 'Dual Monitor' button.



Settings

Color Settings

You can now choose your own color scheme. You can adjust colors for the Grids and Progressbar.



Data/Score Settings


You can choose where Leaderboard should look for the input .epc datafile. You can also select how you want to enter data on the Scores tab. 'By Name', In this mode you select a player name and the partner and the opponents are displayed for easy entry. 'By Table". In this mode, you select a table number and the names of the people at that table are displayed. (currently disabled).

(New in version 3.5.3): Scoring 'Bye Points'. If you have extra players, on each game players will be sitting out. You can assign those players points for those games.

User Settings

This is where you set the 'Tip of the Day' setting.


You can control how many players you display on the Dual Monitor who are 'In The Hunt'.

You can also control over what data gets displayed on the Dual Monitor.
